

Prohibited Items and Behaviors

The Pima County Fairgrounds and the Southwestern Fair Commission, Inc. cooperate with local law enforcement and The Department of Homeland Security recommendations for large-scale events. We work closely with promoters to produce and manage events with public safety being a priority. In so doing, prohibited items and behaviors are enforced by private security and/or law enforcement. Prohibited items and behaviors are subject to change per event and promoter, however below are some of the common prohibited items and behaviors, but is not limited to the following:

*The following items are **NOT** allowed into the concerts:*

Outside food or beverage
Weapons
Drugs
Skateboards, roller skates, roller blades
Gang Attire
Non-service animals
Ice Chests
Video Cameras

The following behaviors can result in removal from the event, without refund:

Acts or threats of violence
Drunken or disorderly Conduct
Destruction of property
Possession and/or use of illegal drugs
Underage drinking
Bootleg merchandising
Solicitation or distribution of promotional materials, literature or vending without prior consent

Video or audio taping of performers can result in your equipment being temporarily confiscated and/or you may be removed from the event.
