

RULES AND REGULATIONS AND GENERAL INFORMATION

"Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Rule Book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith"

LIFE, SENIOR ACTIVE AND JUNIOR ACTIVE MEMBERS SHALL BE ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IN ALL CLASSES AT REGULAR COMPETITIONS, EVENTING COMPETITIONS AT THE PRELIMINARY LEVEL OR ABOVE, AND COMBINED DRIVING COMPETITIONS AT THE ADVANCED LEVEL, DRESSAGE, REINING, AND VAULTING COMPETITIONS AND ENDURANCE RIDES. A NONMEMBER MAY PARTICIPATE AS A HANDLER, RIDER, DRIVER, OWNER, LESSEE, AGENT, COACH OR TRAINER AT REGULAR COMPETITIONS, EVENTING COMPETITIONS, DRESSAGE COMPETITIONS. REINING COMPETITIONS AND COMBINED DRIVING COMPETITIONS, UPON PAYMENT OF A \$30.00 NON MEMBER REGISTRATION FEE. PARTICIPANTS IN THE FOLLOWING CLASSES ARE EXEMPTED FROM THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS RULE; 1) LEADLINE; 2) EXHIBITIONS; 3) GAMES AND RACES; 4) CLASSES FOR 4-H MEMBERS; 5) WALK-TROT AND ACADEMY CLASSES. (Academy Classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program; 6) USDF INTRODUCTORY LEVEL TESTS, PAS DE DEUX AND QUADRILLE CLASSES; 7) NHRA ENDORSED REINING COMPETITIONS; 8) OPPORTUNITY CLASSES; 9) CITIZENS OF OTHER NATIONS, WHO HAVE PROOF IN ENGLISH, OF CURRENT MEMBERSHIP IN GOOD STANDING OF THEIR OWN NATIONAL FEDERATION; 10) USEA BEGINNER NOVICE DIVISION; AND 11) ASSISANT HANDLERS IN DRESSAGE SPORT HORSE BREEDING CLASSES.

USEF Entry Agreement

By entering a Federation licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaultor or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of the United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. ("the Federation") and the local rules of the competition. I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cablecasts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation Rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR 908.4

The Horse Show Management reserves the right to itself to interpret all questions and conditions in regard to or arising out of an incident to the show without claims for damages or recourse of any kind. All questions not covered in these Rules and Regulations shall be decided by the Horse Show Management, their decision to be final.

The Horse Show Management reserves the right to limit entries, refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries; disqualify any riders or exhibitors, prohibit exhibition of entries, and cancel award prizes, without claim for damages; to change any course, to add a dotted line, to cancel or combine any classes, or to reschedule classes, after due notice to exhibitors; to change rings or judges; to change specifications in jumper classes in order to facilitate the time schedule or as competition warrants, or make any changes management deems is in the best interests of the show.

Every horse on the show grounds will be under the control of the Horse Show Management, but Management will, in no case, be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the Horse Show, its members, directors, employees, sponsoring entities and facility harmless for any loss or accident to his/her horse, horses or equipment which may occur from sickness, fire or otherwise.

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS: All horses entering the state of Arizona must have a current health certificate. For any questions, please contact the Arizona State Veterinarian's Office at 602 542 4293

RETURNED CHECKS: Checks returned by the bank for any reason will be charged a \$50.00 NSF fee. Accounts will be given ten days to be paid in full with cash or cash equivalent or they will be turned into the USEF for further disciplinary action.

DOG OWNERS USEF GR1301. 6. DOGS ARE NOT PERMITTED TO BE LOOSE ON THE COMPETITION GROUNDS AND MUST BE ON A LEASH OR OTHERWISE CONTAINED. INDIVIDUALS MUST NOT LEAD DOGS ON A LEASH WHILE MOUNTED. DOG OWNERS ARE SOLELY RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY DAMAGES, CLAIMS, LOSSES, OR ACTIONS RESULTING FROM THEIR DOGS' BEHAVIOR. DOG OWNERS FAILING TO COMPLY WITH THIS RULE MAY BE SUBJECT TO PENALTY UNDER CHAPTERS 6 & 7.

MEDICAL WASTE: Sharps must be disposed of in containers provided in the barn areas or exhibitors will be subject to sanction.

PARKING: The parking of vehicles and horse trailers is not permitted in the barn areas. Upon your arrival, please follow parking signs and/or directions from members of the horse show staff.

MOTOR HOMES: Spaces are limited and are reserved on a first-paid basis only. To reserve a space, you must include the weekly fee of \$140 along with your entry.

MOTORIZED VEHICLES / GOLF CARTS: USEF Rule GR1301.7. Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside, will NOT be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent(s), legal guardian(s), or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s) or guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of these individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. (Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance equipment for people with disabilities are exempt.)

CANADIAN EXHIBITORS: The legend "U.S. Funds" must be printed on the face of any Canadian check drawn on a Canadian bank and used to pay any fees for these shows. Entries received that do not adhere to this policy will be returned. No exceptions.

MEMBERSHIP, MEASUREMENT & AMATEUR CARDS/AFFIDAVITS

All participants (riders, drivers, handlers, owners, trainers, coaches, agents or lessees) must present to the competition secretary a current **USEF/USHJA** membership card or copy thereof, or he/she will be assessed a \$30 (or \$60 if both USEF and USHJA) non refundable non member fee. All junior and pony hunters must possess and present to the horse show office, a current USEF measurement card. All amateur-owners and adult amateurs must present their amateur cards at the time of number pick up. To speed processing, **please** enclose photocopies of these cards with entries

MONEY CLASS ELIGIBILITY: To be eligible for a money and/or jackpot class, entry must have entered and shown **in at least two other classes at this show.**

SECTION ENTRY FEES: After showing in the first class of any section requiring a section entry fee, no refunds will be given for scratching classes within the section for any reason.

STABLING AND PADDOCKS: Whether occupied by horses, feed or tack, stalls will be available for \$125.00 Week 1 and \$175.00 Weeks 2 & 3, without bedding. Stalls are permanent or temporary with doors. A \$35.00 per day Office/Facility Fee will be charged for horses that are showing which have not purchased a stall. Paddocks will be available for \$150.00/\$300.00 per week. Large paddocks and personal schooling rings may be available.

NON SHOWING HORSES: Non Showing horses must pay a stall fee, if using a stall, a \$35.00 Office/Facility Fee and a \$50.00 Non Showing Fee. Horses not using a stall will be charged the \$50.00 Non Showing Fee and a one time per week \$35.00 Office/Facility Fee – in addition, they are subject to all the rules and regulations of the show. **Trainer owned non showing horses will be charged a stall fee only. Owners that have horses entered and showing will be allowed to bring non showing horses and pay stall fee only.**

FEED & BEDDING: Feed and bedding is available through the horse show office. Orders must be placed in the horse show office by 12:00 noon for same day delivery. For deliveries prior to arrival, please call the fairgrounds office at 520 762 9100. Exhibitors who bring their own shavings will be subject to a disposal fee.

MINOR EXHIBITORS: Parents or guardian of minor exhibitors shall hold the Tucson Fall Preview, Tucson Fall Festival Horse Show and the Tucson Fall Classic Horse Show, Southwestern Fair Commission DBA as Pima County Fairgrounds and Show Management harmless for injury to such minor.

ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE: Arrival after 10:00 a.m. on Monday/ Departure by 10:00 a.m. on each following Monday. Early arrivals and late departures must be arranged in advance. Contact Jeff Gilbert at 818 259 4459.

TRAINER SPLITS

The Tucson Fall Horse Shows offer a service to trainers that allows the trainer to purchase shavings, feed, tack stalls, paddocks, golf carts etc. directly from the Horse Show and then split the total amount for some or all of these items and have it charged directly to their client's horse show bill. Any horse show secretary can assist the trainer in this process. Trainer splits will be accepted until noon on Friday (no exceptions) of each show week. Please advise your clients that these charges will appear on their show bill. Only dollar amounts will be split (not quantities) and totals will be rounded up to the next whole dollar amount. Trainers are reminded that this is a service provided by the Horse Show and that doing splits in a timely manner is their responsibility. Additionally, any splits uncollected from the client will revert back to the trainer for payment.

Please Note: Only amounts billed by the horse show to the trainer may be included in the split.

SCHOOLING POLICY:

HUNTER RINGS: On schooling day, hunter rings will be open for schooling. Times will be posted in the horse show office. Each morning during the show, hunter rings will close 45 minutes prior to the start of classes. Hunter rings may be open for schooling after being reset by the jump crew, time permitting.

JUMPER RING: Week 1 – Thursday in Jumper Ring 1 - Class # 601 - 1.10m Warm Up Jumper, Table II 10:00-12:00 and Class #600 - 0.95m Warm Up Jumper, Table II - 1:00-3:00. Week 2 and 3 – Tuesday, in Jumper Ring 2, Class # 601 1.10m Warm Up Jumper, Table II - 10:00-12:00 and Class #600 0.95m Warm Up Jumper, Table II - 1:00-3:00 p.m. Thursday in Jumper Ring 2, Class 602 – 0.95 Warm Up Jumper, Table II – 10:00-12:00 and Class 603 – Warm Up Jumper, Table II – 1:00-3:00. Each morning during the show, jumper ring 2 will be open for hacking. No jumping.

NOTE: In any case, no schooling will be allowed after 6:00 p.m. in any of the rings.

HORSE SHOW OFFICE: The horse show office will be open daily from 7:00 a.m. until ½ hour after the end of classes.

OFFICE/FACILITY FEE: Every horse entered will be charged an Office Fee of \$35.00.

REFUNDS: Before the closing date of entries, all fees shall be refunded. After the closing date of entries, prior to arrival on the show grounds, all fees except a \$25 Show Scratch Fee, the office charge and the \$175.00 stall fee shall be refunded only upon presentation of a statement signed by a Veterinarian (or medical doctor in the case of a rider) stating that the horse (rider) is unable to perform in the classes entered. All scratches must be submitted in writing to be considered for a refund; phone call scratches will not be considered. REFUND REQUESTS MUST BE SUBMITTED BY THE END OF THE SHOW. NO REFUND REQUESTS WILL BE CONSIDERED AFTER THE HORSE SHOW HAS CONCLUDED. **AFTER THE CLOSING DATE OF ENTRIES, STALL FEES ARE NOT REFUNDABLE UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES**

LATE ENTRIES: There will be a charge of \$50.00 per horse on all entries post marked after the closing date of entries.

RDNE Rode Did Not Enter: Entries that show in a class that was not properly entered will be charged the regular class entry fee, plus a \$20.00 RDNE Fee per class.

PROFESSIONALS: Please read this and inform your customers that exhibitor numbers will not be issued by the secretary until entry forms are correctly and completely filled out and arrangements for payment are completed.

ALL TRAINERS WILL BE REQUIRED TO LEAVE AN OPEN CHECK OR PHOTO COPY OF CREDIT CARD IN THE HORSE SHOW OFFICE UPON CHECK IN.

COURTESY CIRCLE - Management may at any time decide to limit the Courtesy Circle in any Hunter Class. A notice will be given and the limits of the courtesy will be posted on the course plan and will be announced.

DAY HAULERS : Allowed with prior permission from show management. There will be a day hauler fee of \$25 per horse/per show.

ADDS/SCRATCHES DURING SHOW

DECLARE ALL CLASSES BY 5:00 P.M. THE DAY BEFORE CLASSES ARE HELD. A TRANSACTION FEE OF \$10.00 PER ADD/SCRATCH SHEET WILL BE CHARGED IF CHANGES ARE MADE ON THE SAME DAY AS THE CLASSES ARE HELD. ENTRY FEES FOR WEATHER RELATED SCRATCHES WILL NOT BE REFUNDED.

HORSE REGISTRATION NUMBERS

All horses competing in Federation non breed restricted licensed competitions with hunter, hunter breeding, jumper and hunter seat equitation classes (except those activities enumerated in GR 901.9, items 1-9) must be properly identified and must obtain a Registration Number from the USHJA. A registration number for each horse must be entered on all entry forms for licensed competitions. Only one Horse Registration Number will be issued per horse, and must remain with the horse throughout its career. Anyone knowingly applying for a duplicate Registration Number for an individual horse may be subject to disciplinary action. The Federation and/or USHJA as applicable must be notified of any change of ownership and/or competition name of the horse. Owners are requested to notify the Federation and/or the USHJA as applicable of corrections to previously submitted information, e.g., names, addresses, breed registration, pedigree, or markings. Applications for Registration Numbers can be completed online at www.ushja.org or www.usef.org using the Horse Registration application form. The Horse application form is also available from the USHJA or Federation office, or it can be downloaded from the USHJA or Federation website or from competition management. **HORSES MUST STILL BE RECORDED WITH THE USEF (EITHER LIFETIME OR ANNUAL) TO RECEIVE NATIONAL OR ZONE POINTS. See USEF Rules EQ 100.2, HU 101.1, And JP101.2.**

ENTRY PROCEDURES: Each horse entered in any classes in the Open and Junior/Amateur-Owner Jumper sections, must send in the \$100 Jumper Nominating Fee and your stall fee. If you plan to haul in and not use a stall, send any appropriate nominating fees along with a \$35 Office/Facility Fee. Send with your completed entry blank on or before the closing date of entries. Bring a check for the remainder of the fees to the show. **NO NUMBERS WILL BE ISSUED WITHOUT FULL PAYMENT.** A signed, open check or a photo copy of your credit card must be left for classes that are added during the show. **NO STALLS RESERVED WITHOUT PAYMENT IN FULL.**

ENTRY CLOSING: The entry closing date for the Tucson Fall Preview, Tucson Fall Festival and the Tucson Fall Classic is Friday, October 10, 2011. Entries must be postmarked by this date to be considered on-time.

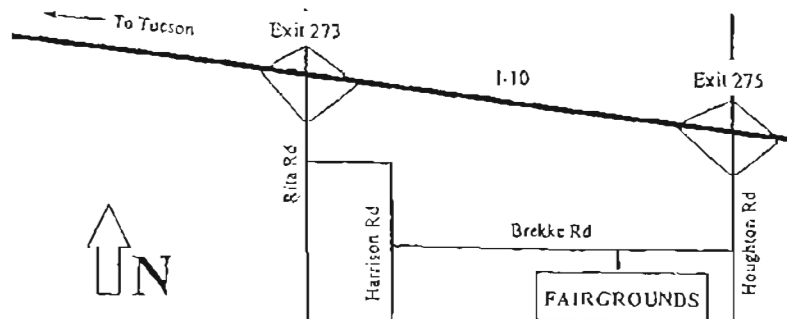

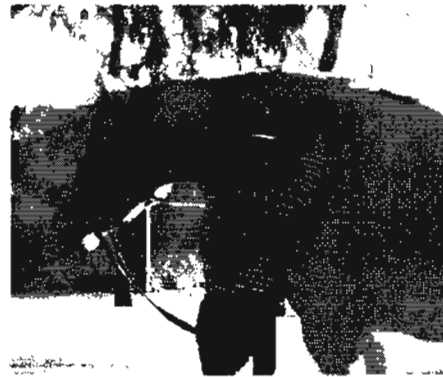

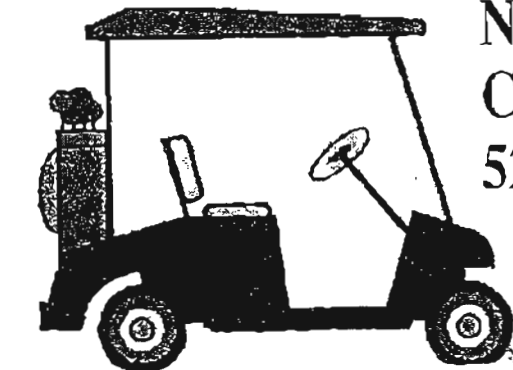

The height of the jumps will begin at 3'6" and ascend to 4'0-4'3" as determined by management. Each competitor will jump the series of verticals and receive either faults (4 per rail) and at which jump to determine placings for competitors not receiving a clear score) **OR** a clear score. Note: If a competitor refuses at any one of the "5 bars" they must begin again at the fence where the refusal took place. They will be penalized 4 faults for each refusal. (2 refusals will eliminate.) After each round, if two or more are tied with equal scores, the fences are raised one hole. To be held at the Tucson Fall Festival – November 2-6, 2011

ELIGIBILITY

Horses must be recorded with USEF prior to the start of the Tucson Fall Festival Horse Show. – **NO ENTRY FEE**
Winners will receive an Award, ribbons through 6th place. Zone 8 Grand Championships to be awarded at the Arizona's Year End Awards Banquet or for the Northeast at the Zone final show. One judge will preside over both the Southwest Finals in Tucson and the Northeast Finals in Denver and the same Jumper courses will be set at both events. This years Judge will be Walter J. Lee and the Jumper Course Designer for the original classes will be Hector Loyola. The Hunter Course Designer will be Brian Post. The Judge will determine his choice in each division between the two Finals and the best Jumper Scores will be determined between the two as well.

FORMAT

Hunter Classes – You must enter the Southwest Zone Finals in the horse show office prior to the start of the classes that count toward the Southwest Zone Finals Championship. Three classes out of each division will be designated as the Southwest Zone Final classes. For all Divisions held on Wednesday, Thursday and Friday will count the **FINAL** two jumping classes and the Under Saddle . Divisions held on Saturday and Sunday (Adult Amateur, Children's, Pony, Amateur-Owner and Junior Hunter) will count the **FIRST** two jumping classes and the under saddle. The open numerical scoring system will be used ,scores will be given to each horse in the Under Saddle. The scores from the three classes will be added to determine the winner. In the case of a tie the second score will determine the winner. Ties for other than first place will remain tied. No entry fee for Southwest Zone classes, but will not be eligible for other awards.

Jumper Classes – You must enter the Southwest Zone Finals in the horse show office prior to the start of the class that counts toward the Southwest Zone Final Championship. The highest placing Children's Jumper entry and the highest placing Adult Amateur Jumper entry in the Children's/Adult Amateur Classic will be designated the Southwest Zone Finals Champion in their respective division. The highest placing entry in the Junior/Amateur-Owner Jumper Classic will be designated the Southwest Zone Finals Champion for that division. Separate Southwest Zone Finals classes will not be held. No entry fee, but will not be eligible for other awards.
