

Events at the Pima County Fairgrounds and COVID-19

Social distancing, handwashing, hand sanitizing and the use of cloth face coverings as required by Pima County will be abided by all vendors and staff working events taking place at the fairgrounds. Per Pima County Resolution, attendees of events held at the Pima County Fairgrounds are to wear a face covering waiting in line, at the food stands, restrooms and in areas where social distancing is difficult to maintain. For public safety, food areas will be spaced apart and cleaned regularly. Bathrooms will be open and cleaned on a regular basis. Handwashing and hand sanitizing stations will be located throughout. Social distancing will be encouraged. Congregating is discouraged.
