How do I get there? I/10 to Houghton Rd. South one mile to Brekke Rd. Right on Brekke, follow the signs.

What time does parking open and when is show time for Monsters Inc?

Parking opens at 6:00 p.m. Showtime is 8:00 p.m.

What time does parking open and when is show time for Jurassic Park?

Parking opens at opens at 9:45. Showtime is 10:15 p.m.

I bought the double feature, do I have to leave and repark? No. You will remain in your parking spot or move forward to another location, once Monsters Inc has cleared out.

What type of vehicles are allowed? Standard trucks and cars only. No RVS or trailers.

Will I be able to leave my parking spot to attend the Fair Food Roud Up: Yes.

Will there be Social Distancing? Yes. Bathrooms and concession stands will have 6-foot markers and signage. Picnic tables will be spaced throughout the food court for social distancing.

Will I be able to place lawn chairs or a blanket outside of my vehicle? Yes. You must maintain social distancing and remain within the immediate vicinity of your vehicle.

Does everyone have to wear a face covering? No. Some people are exempt; Children under 5, individuals with certain medical conditions, the hearing impaired or who are communicating with the hearing impaired, where the ability to see the mouth is essential for communication. When is ok to remove my face covering? When you are In your vehicle or outside of your vehicle, so long as are with members of your own household or party and 6 feet away from others who are not members of your own household or party. When you are eating or drinking.

What safety measures will be in place? The event will be staffed with security, bathrooms, tables, and counters will be cleaned regularly, handwashing and hand sanitizing will be located throughout the event.

What else do I need to know? No ice chests, outside food or beverages, fireworks, or pets allowed.
