KNOW BEFORE YOU GO:

**Fair Food Round Up:
Friday, June 26 – Sunday, June 28th.**

How much does it cost to park and to enter? *Admission and parking are both free.*

What time are doors? *4:00 p.m.*

How do I get there? *I/10 to Houghton Rd. Exit #275. South one mile to Brekke Rd. Right on Brekke, follow the signs to the FAIR FOOD ROUND UP*

Will there be seating? *Yes. Picnic tables will available on a first come first served basis. Families are also invited to bring their own lawn chairs or blankets seek out shaded areas, distanced from others.*

What if I don't want to sit at a picnic table? *Food can be ordered to go. Families are invited to bring their own lawn chairs and/or blankets and select their own shaded area, away from others.*

Will there be Social Distancing? *Yes. Bathrooms and concession stands will have 6-foot markers and signage. Picnic tables will be spaced throughout for social distancing.*

Will face coverings be required? *Yes. Per Pima County Resolution. Read the resolution here:*

Does everyone have to wear a face covering? *No. Some people are exempt; Children under 5, individuals with certain medical conditions, the hearing impaired or who are communicating with the hearing impaired, where the ability to see the mouth is essential for communication. Other individuals and circumstances are exempt. See the list of exemptions here:*

When is ok to remove my face covering? *In your vehicle. When you are with members of your own household or party and 6 feet away from others who are not members of your own household or party.*

What other safety measures will be in place? *The event will be staffed with security, bathrooms, tables, and counters will be cleaned regularly, handwashing and hand sanitizing will be located throughout the event.*

Is this the fair? Will there be carnival rides? *No.*

What else do I need to know? *No ice chests, outside food or beverages, or pets allowed.*

COVID-19 Warning and Assumption of Risk: The Pima County Fairgrounds is working with Pima County to take proper precautions to keep our staff and guests as safe as possible while visiting the Pima County Fairgrounds and RV Park.
