Drive In Movies: KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

How much does it cost to park and to enter: \$15.00 per movie, per car. Double Feature purchase options are available. Get Tickets at www.TheFoat.com

How do I get there? I/10 to Houghton Rd. South one mile to Brekke Rd. Right on Brekke, to Harrison Rd. Left on Harrison to the 3rd gate on the left.

What time does parking open and when is Show Time? Parking opens at 6:00 p.m. Showtime is 8:00 p.m.* For Double Feature Nights, the 2nd film parking will open at 10:00 p.m. with showtime at 10:30 p.m.* Show times are approximate due to daylight or weather delays.

I bought a double feature, do I have to leave and repark? No. You will remain in your parking spot or move forward to another location, once the first movie parking has cleared out.

What type of vehicles are allowed? Standard trucks and cars only. No RVS or trailers.

Will I be able to leave my parking spot to access the concessions area? Yes, you must wear a face covering when accessing walking to/from and when in line for the bathrooms or concessions areas.

Will there be Social Distancing? Yes. Bathrooms and concession stands will have 6-foot markers and signage. Picnic tables will be spaced throughout the food court for social distancing.

Will I be able to place lawn chairs or a blanket outside of my vehicle? Yes. You must maintain social distancing and remain within the immediate vicinity of your vehicle. Cars are spaced for apart for 2 – 4 chairs in front of your vehicle or directly on the left of your vehicle.

Will face coverings be required? Yes. Per Pima County Resolution.

Does everyone have to wear a face covering? No. Some people are exempt; Children under 5, individuals with certain medical conditions, the hearing impaired or who are communicating with the hearing impaired. Read the resolution for a listing of exemptions.

When is ok to remove my face covering? When you are In or within the immediate vicinity of your vehicle, so long as are with members of your own household or party and are 6 feet away from others who are not members of your own household or party. When you are eating or drinking.

What safety measures will be in place? The event will be staffed with security, bathrooms, tables, and counters will be cleaned regularly, handwashing and hand sanitizing will be located throughout the event.

What else do I need to know? No ice chests, outside food or beverages, fireworks, or pets allowed.
